
Students: Our Core Mission (I)


- TC adds value to student experience through industry exposure, seminars by authorities in the field, travel funds for conferences, fellowship stipends— essential differentiator for recruiting top talent





Chicago Red Light Camera Report

- Assessment of Chicago's RLC program impact on safety
- Overall decrease in injury-producing crashes attributed to RLC enforcement
- Significant safety "spillover effect" to non-RLC intersections
- Recommended grace period extension
- Methodology for continuing performance assessment and scoring intersections.
